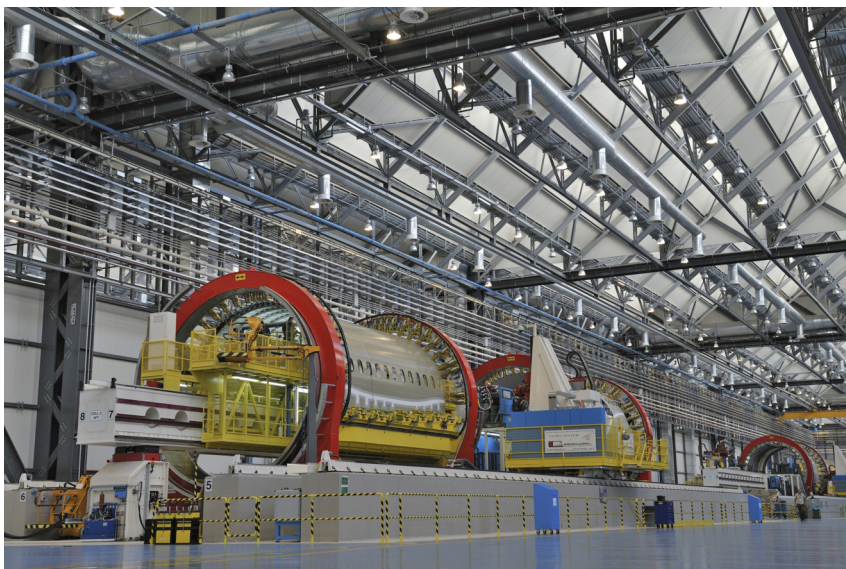

### **Advanced Composites the Driver for High Performance Return**

SETEC 10 Brindisi is the 5<sup>th</sup>. Technical Conference and Table Top Exhibition of SAMPE Europe, which was launched 1996 in Toulouse focusing the A-380 Programme of AIRBUS. The SETEC Conference of the following years 1997–1999 have been organized and held in Madrid, Augsburg and Filton, all three locations are known as important Developing and Manufacturing Centres of the European Aerospace-Industry. For SETEC 10, Brindisi, South Italy has been defined and selected because of the high potential and importance for the Aerospace Industries as a whole. Despite the financial and economic difficulties of the past 18-24 months, substantial investments have been made by several Aerospace related Companies and Organisations all located in the very attractive landscape of Southern Adriatic Italy.

The “Theme” of SETEC 10 stating “**Advanced Composites the Driver for High Performance Return**” reflects the dedication of the Aerospace Industry in Southern Italy to provide to their customer a highest possible performance, to get an excellence in service return, of all Components, Structures or entire Systems designed and processed in this South European Region.

All attendees of SETC 10 will be invited to witness the capabilities of the Aerospace Industry of this region by attending to the presentation of their papers at SETEC 10. Of course complementary papers from leading Industries being active in Research and Development, Materials, Design, Engineering and Processing coming from other European Countries, Russia or Overseas Region or Continents will provide a good reference of the latest achievements realized for the Aerospace Industry.

### **Call for Papers**

The joint team of SAMPE Europe and SAMPE Italy invites Designers, Engineers, Researchers, Processors and Manufacturers, being active in or for the Aerospace Industry to present their latest development, creation, achievement, test-results and new application in the field of High Performance Advanced Composites at SETEC 10 Brindisi, by submitting an **Abstract of 200 word** maximum for judgement and selection by the Scientific Committee of SAMPE Europe. The abstract shall be received by April 30<sup>st</sup>. 2010, at the latest, by e-mail to SEBO@sampe-europe.org.

During May all submitter of abstract will be informed of the selection taken. Authors of papers who will be invited for presentation will be requested to remit the file of the respective paper not later than June 30<sup>th</sup>. 2010. Speaker/Authors of selected papers will get a substantial reduction of the registration fee proposed, which will be structured on a “all inclusive basis” for the conference with welcome reception, coffee breaks, two lunch, SETEC 10 Dinner, and Conference Proceedings.

### **Venue of SETEC 10**

SETEC 10 will be organized by the joint team of **SAMPE Europe** and **Consorzio CETMA**, a well known centre of Research, Testing and Teaching in the field of Advanced Composites and applied Technologies, the **Università del Salento** and hosted in Technological Park “**Cittadella della Ricerca**”, where CETMA is located. Cittadella della Ricerca Park is located approx 4 km outside Brindisi – along the Regional Highway SS 7, in direction of Taranto, at km 706,03 (2<sup>nd</sup> exit on the right coming from Brindisi).

Cittadella della Ricerca offers an excellent infrastructures for the Conference and for the Table Top Exhibition, where up to 30 units, will be proposed for renting in the Preliminary Programme, due to be published in early May 2010. In addition to the available infrastructure for the Conference and the Table Top Exhibition, this complex offers also the possibility to rent Hotel rooms for attractive rates, in the building next to the Table Top Exhibition. Details for booking rooms at the Hotel “Foresteria Dei Congressi” – or of other proposed hotels, located in down-town Brindisi, will be published in the Preliminary Programme.

The Cittadella della Ricerca Conference, Table Top and Hotel enjoys of an extended car parking. For delegates with Hotel accommodation in Hotels in down-town Brindisi, a free Shuttle-Bus Service will operate in the morning and later afternoon, after closure of the last session, between Hotels and CETMA, and vice-versa.

### **SETEC 10 TABLE TOP EXHIBITION**

Very next to the Conference Auditorium is located the Hotel "Foresteria dei Congressi" with a large Atrium where the Table Top Exhibition will be set up with approx 30 Units, each consisting of a Table (1600 x 800 mm minimum) two chairs and electricity supply for connecting your computer and spot-lights for getting correct illumination of your exhibits. The layout plan of the Table Tops to be rented will be published in the Preliminary Programme. Renting costs per unit will be € 800.00, the same as applied in the past years.

The catering of all SETEC 10 attendees will be organized in the Table Top Area. This means the daily morning and afternoon Coffee-Break, and the Lunch will be served in the Table Top Area. By this concept, all Table Top Exhibitor will get the opportunity provided to attract during 4 hours (!) all delegates of SETEC 10 Conference with their exposures and messages. This concept provides an excellent platform for all exhibitor to held good conversations and to define new relations with potential new customers.

### **How to reach BRINDISI and Cittadella della Ricerca?**

Brindisi is located on the Southern Shore of the Adriatic Sea – in between Bari and Lecce. Brindisi's Airport is integrated in the Italian and European Network. From Rome and Milan several daily flights, in both directions are operated. Other important Italian and European Network direct flights are proposed in by different operators.

By car you can reach Brindisi on the Highway "Autostrada" A1 coming from Milano to Bologna, and the A14 to Rimini – Ancona – Pescara – Foggia – Bari – to Brindisi. From Rome you will reach Brindisi via A1 to Napoli (Naples) – and the A16 / A14 to Bari. FS (Italian Railway System) connect Brindisi to Rome and Bologna / Milano and vice-versa with several daily Express Train Services. Cittadella della Ricerca is located 4 km outside Brindisi City – along the Regional Motorway SS 7, 2<sup>nd</sup>. Exit (km 706,030) in direction of Taranto.

### **Hotel Accomodation**

Attendees of SETEC 10 Conference will get the possibility proposed to select hotel rooms from four different Hotels and categories. In Cittadella della Ricerca, the Hotel "Foresteria dei Congressi" offers 60 rooms in the Table Top Exhibition Atrium Building at rates from € 50.00 – 80.00. In down-town Brindisi the "Gran Hotel Internazionale" (\*\*\*\*) located directly at the shore of the City proposes 67 room at € 90.00-135.00, incl. breakfast. The Hotel Nettuno \*\*\* is located in the harbour area and offers 80 rooms at € 85.00-125.00, breakfast included. The Masseria Marziale, located in the green outside the city near the Airport, offers a large swimming pool and open air Restaurant with 20 rooms at € 89,00, breakfast included. Detailed information will be published early May 2010, in the Preliminary Programme.

### **SETEC 10 PLANT TOUR**

With the appreciated support of several sponsor Companies, it is intended to propose two Visit Plant Tour to all SETEC 10 attendees. There will be a visit proposed to ALENIA Aeronautica Composite Plant in Grottaglie (approx 45 km from Brindisi) where a large fuselage section of Boeing's Dream-Liner B-787 is being manufactured!

The second visit plant tour proposed will go to AgustaWestland, and I.A.S at the Brindisi Airport Area, with in addition to see the new, state-of-the-art Prepreg-Plant of Technologycom. The registration form for attending one of those plant tours will be published in the Preliminary Programme, by early May 2010.

### **SETEC 10 CONFERENCE DINNER**

The SETEC 10 Conference Dinner will be organized as an integrated element of the registration, on Thursday evening, September 16<sup>th</sup>., 2010, at the Masseria Marziale located at the entrance to the City in the Greens. This Restaurant offers the possibility to have Aperitif and Dinner under "open-air" if the weather will be favourable.

### **Cultural Aspects of Brindisi and his country-site**

At the time of the old Roman Empire, the Port of Brindisi got a high importance for the commercial and cultural exchange with the old Greece. Even today in the 21<sup>st</sup>. Century those links to Greece are still of importance by operating several daily Ferry departures across the Adriatic Sea to Patras, Corfu or Igoumenitsa. In the City of Brindisi an interesting amount of Roman archaeological monuments can be visited to show evidence of the very rich heritage of more than 2000 years of age. From 12<sup>th</sup>. and 13<sup>th</sup> century, which was an other very dynamic epoch for Brindisi, several very impressive construction show evidence like the Cathedral or the Santa Maria del Casale, San Paolo, San Giovanni al Sepolcro or San Benedetto, or the beautiful “Castello Svevo” erected in 1227 by Federico the 2nd to protect the port of Brindisi from invasion from the sea.

Other interesting towns and cities are less than 50km far from Brindisi: Lecce, 35 km South direction, is the best representative of the Italian Barocco architecture style; Valle d'Itria, 35 km North-West direction, is an area in which towns and villages (Martina Franca, Locorotondo, Alberobello, Ceglie) worth to be visited due to their typical ancient stone houses, named Trulli, and a number of olive trees and vineyards. In regard of cooking the region has a high reputation of excellent Sea Food, Meat, Pasta and the outstanding local Wines! You should taste them all!
